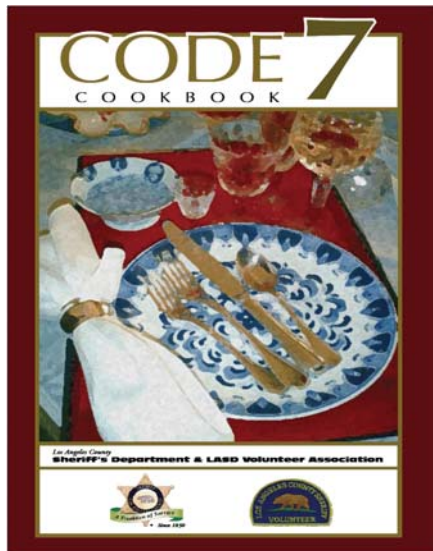
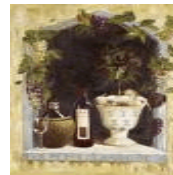


Here it is!
