The position's costs are split between the City of San Dimas and the District using a COPS/DOJ Grant and a School Community Policing Partnership Grant. The General duties and activities involved in this position are as follows:

Crime Prevention Duties:

- \* Identify children heading into criminal/disruptive behavior patterns
- \* Liaison between the School District and the Sheriff's Station
- Patrol at schools: reports, detentions, and arrests due to crime on campus
- \* Assist campus supervisors and staff
- \* Lecture on Crime Prevention
- \* Assist school personnel with student searches and arrests
- \* Provide Additional campus security
- \* Update and create School Emergency Operations Response Plans

Community Relations:

- \* Interaction with students
- \* Assist students with conflict resolution, gang and drug problems
- \* Assist with traffic problems
